- 33 Six hellebore florets to be exhibited on damp sand or oasis
- 34 A container of any growing bulbous plants in flower
- 35 A vase of 3 kinds of flowering shrub or tree
- 36 A vase of flowers of any one kind not mentioned in classes 18-33 (max. nine stems)
- 37 One bloom camellia, outdoor grown (own container)
- 38 An alpine or alpines in a pot or pan
- 39 An exhibit of any vegetable (number optional)
